Ideally suited for **Years 1 & 2**

Length: **35 minute performance followed by a 15 minute workshop**

The performance and workshop include topics such as enjoying walking to school, caring for the environment, taking exercise and travelling safely.

In the course of the performance and the follow up workshop, children learn and experience valuable information about road safety on their way to and from school. In particular:

- Using the road crossing code of STOP, LOOK, LISTEN, LIVE.
- Being safe and being seen. Wearing safe and appropriate clothing
- Sustainable transport and alternative modes of travel including walking, cycling and public transport.
