

Ideally suited for **Year 9**

Performance length: **60 minutes**

Audience number: **approximately 150**

Venue: **ideally on the flat in a school hall with the audience on three sides (see below)**

Box Clever presents a dramatic new performance focusing on the importance of seat-belt wearing and the consequences of failing to do so, even just for a moment. The performance is highly engaging and interactive and resonates emotionally with its young audience. As the drama unfolds, the actors and facilitator present the students with familiar and recognisable situations and actions and the stark consequences of decisions that they may make when a passenger in a car.

The play centres on a specific case study concerning two young people, not much older than those in the audience, and charts their journey from a party to a seemingly inevitable fate. Interacting directly with audience members, the company re-enact the scene to investigate how things could be different, if only seat belts had been worn.
